- Mobility: \*Able to rise from a standing squat
- \*\* If adult supervision is available for 24 hours

## **Maternal support:**

- Low: Non-acute conditions but requiring continued hospitalization (e.g. observation after complicated vaginal delivery)
- Moderate: Ongoing acute conditions requiring continued hospitalization and intermittent IV fluid/medications (e.g. chorioamnionitis requiring IV antibiotics, hypertension off magnesium)
- High: Medically high risk requiring transport by RN/MD and/or continuous IV medication infusion (e.g. preeclampsia with severe features on magnesium, insulin dependent diabetes on IV insulin)
